What is an Interactive PowerPoint Family Tree?

- 1. A pedigree chart that you can "walk" through
- 2. It uses Hyperlinks to create interactivity in a presentation
- 3. Contains objects that takes you to places you define
- 4. Contains documentation or links to the history of people, places, events or references

Why did I use PowerPoint to create my family tree?

- 1. Worldwide. I have relatives in China and Hong Kong viewing and updating my family tree
- 2. Available on every electronic platform
- 3. Easy to view
- 4. Free PowerPoint Viewer from Microsoft
- 5. Convertible to PDF format
- 6. Microsoft is not going out of business soon
- 7. Free software with OpenOffice, for PC and Mac from Apache if you don't have PowerPoint

What are the drawbacks?

- 1. Need to know how to create PowerPoint slides
- 2. Need for some training to use Hyperlinks (hopefully we fix that today)

What is a Hyperlink?

In my words: "Click on something, go some place and you determine where that place is".

There are many types of Hyperlinks, 4 is all you need

- 1. Go to slide within a presentation
- 2. Go to slide in another file (presentation)
- 3. Action Buttons: Go to 1st slide, second slide, last slide, previous, exit show
- 4. Go to a URL in the world wide web
